The 11th Edition of La Salle-URL Architecture Workshop faces common challenges in modern cities. such as tourism, climate emergencies and the responsible use of public space.

The student will work on a real situation and the reflections presented during the Architecture Workshop will be the basis of the future projection of Barcelona, in constant evolution

Providing new urban and architectural solutions for the Olympic Port is a real problem in the city that the Barcelona City Council exposes. Throughout the Summer School Architecture Workshop you will have to find a solution to this issue.

The Olympic Port was originally projected as sports equipment, with the aim of revitalizing the waterfront of Barcelona. It was inaugurated in 1992, coinciding with the Olympic Games, and was a huge transformation of the Barcelona coast.

However, although it was initially linked to sports use, it soon resulted in recreational use, and over the years it has evolved into a nightlife area focused on tourism, without prioritizing neighbourhood needs, a model that society considers exhausted and in need of reflection

The final solution will require an analysis and prior knowledge of the city, in order to feel and internalize the essence of Mediterranean architecture and transfer tradition to modernity.
