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

 - b. We were two people splitting the rent, which was in total 1200 euro per month, but I met several people who told me that this is almost the price you sometimes par per person.
- I had expenses like a LIME subscription to use electric bikes, some metro tickets, grocery shopping and café, bar and restaurant visites (by far the biggest expence).
 - I it has for me to say if I spend more or less money than I budgeted with, but it was more costly than I had thought. But worth it for sure!
- My income during my stay was solely my SU and Erasmus grant.
 - I did apply for a couple funds/grants, but have not received anything so far.
